We, the Student Council of Civil, Environmental and Geodetic Engineers wish you all the best for your start in your study program. We volunteer as student representatives for the departments of Civil, Environmental, Geodetic and Geological Engineering to improve the situation of students. Our official name is “**Fachschaft Bau, Umwelt und Vermessung**”. Alongside our printing service we organize events, provide lockers, sell engineering standards, lend calculators... We also represent you within departments’ bodies and inform you about legal affairs happening at the University. Here you can also seek advice regarding any and all questions you might have about your student life in Germany – feel free to ask one of us. After all, we are all students – like you. For your first days at TUM we provide you an event to help you get to know the university and – which is the most important thing – get to know each other.

- Tuesday, 23rd April
 - **General introduction** by the study coordinators; room and time: look on our website
 - Afterwards: campus tours
- Wednesday, 24th April
 - 8 pm, **Pub crawl**: we are going to show you some places where you can have a drink (or two). Therefore, we will split you into groups with different routes. At the final destination, we will all meet up again. (meeting point is again the square between the two bridges)
- Tuesday, 30rd April
 - 7 pm, **Welcome Evening** in the room of the student representation (room N2157). After the first week has passed, you might have some new questions about your studies or else. We will meet up in a relaxed atmosphere while having drinks and some snacks. We also want to show you some of the things we do at the student council.

Services and student council activities

Printing Service

General Conditions

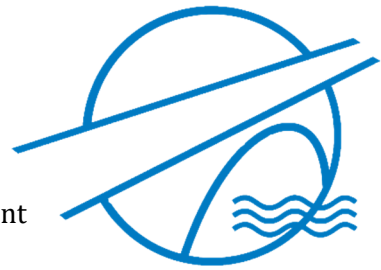
We are proud to offer a printing service in our rooms. This includes bindings for thesis or other projects with spiral or book-like bindings. In general, we have no official opening hours, but most of the time somebody is there to help you – simply ask. Sometimes we need to do our other duties as student representatives, so the doors are not open every time– thank you for understanding that the printing service is not always available.

Payment

Keeping the price as low as possible is very important for us. You can print one b/w page for 3 cts.

Note: you have to pay for your printing in cash – search for “Druckerkasse” behind the computers; most of the time there is enough money to change in our honesty box.

Color printing: you need to choose the printer “Farbe [Zazu]”. Your printing order then needs to be confirmed by one of us – please ask, should you want to issue a color print.

Lockers

University policy and elections

We do not only provide services to you; it is also our task to represent you in the University's bodies. Every year in **June** the University elections are held. We always run for the Faculty's council and the student representation with our own list – see below.

Faculty's Council

The Faculty's council is the highest institution of the BGU Department. It discusses & decides about the exams regulations and the general study regulations of our department. It also decides about PhD admissions and other important affairs. Two student representatives – two candidates on the election list with the most votes – are elected to this council every year. Their task is to control the decisions and to influence the direction our faculty progresses.

Faculty's Student Representation

The rest of the list builds the student representation together with the two faculty's council's members (2+2). They are elected to advise you and to solve conflicts with the University. Three members of faculty's student representation are elected in the University's student's council. They are the highest student's institution of TUM.
